This Privacy and Data Protection policy ("Policy") together with our Terms of Website Use of efffactor.com (and any other documents referred to in it) sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following terms carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. Personal Data We May Collect From You

We may collect and process the following data about you:

Personal data you give us

You may give us personal data about you by filling in forms on the Website or by corresponding with us by phone, email or otherwise. This includes personal data you provide when you register or subscribe to use any of the features on the Website, contact us or when you report a problem with the Website. The personal data you give us may include your name, e-mail address and phone number, identification no. (PAN no./GSTIN/Passport no./Aadhar Card No./CIN (Company Registration no) or website url as applicable.

Personal data we collect about you

With regard to each of your visits to the Website, we may automatically collect the following data:

- technical information, including the IP address used to connect your device to the internet, your login information, device type, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform; and
- o information about your visit, including the full URL clickstream to, through and from the Website (including data and time); services you viewed or searched for; page response times; download errors; length of visits to certain pages; page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks and mouse-overs); and methods used to browse away from the page.
- Personal data we receive from third parties

We work closely with third parties (including, for example: business partners, sub-contractors in technical, payment and delivery services; advertising networks; analytics providers; search information providers; and credit reference agencies) and may receive personal data about you from them.

Uses Made of Your Personal Data

We use personal data held about you as follows:

- Personal data you give us

 - o to provide you with information about other services we offer that are similar to those that you have already received or enquired about;

Personal data we collect about you

• Personal data we receive from third parties

- we may combine this personal data with personal data you give to us and personal data we collect about you; and

Payments & Invoicing

We request use of credit cards or other payment account information, which would be used solely for processing payments. No other information will be stored other than name and address of the card holder, the expiry date and the last four digits of the credit card number. Subject to your prior consent and where necessary for processing future payments, your financial information will be stored in encrypted form on secure servers of our payment gateway service provider whose duty is treat your personal information in accordance with this privacy policy statement.

External Links

On our website there would be some external links. Our advice is that you verify the privacy policies of such other website. We would not be responsible for any misuse of information made by you on such other websites. Illegal activity

For any suspected activity or any violation of terms and conditions of the Eff Factor Software, we would have right to access and share your personal information and contents of your user account to our employees and service providers. However, Eff Factor would make sure that such access is in adherence to the Privacy Policy statement and subject to appropriate confidentiality and security measures.

Blogs and Forums

We provide a platform for users to post information in blogs and forums for sharing information on the website.
